

NAME

compactcmd - compact an access database

SYNOPSIS

compactcmd FILE [OPTION]

DESCRIPTION

Compacting FILE which must be a access database.

[-b=OPTION]

The OPTION on/off activate/disable retry on error (activated by default)

[-s=SEC]

SEC specified the number of seconds to wait until retrying (default 10)

[-t=NUMBER]

start retry attempts NUMBER times if an error occur (default 10)

[-h]

display this help

By default the only argument which is necessary is FILE. All other options have default values. If an invalid parameter is provided it will be ignored and the default value is used. Note that you have to enclose FILE with double quotes if FILE contains spaces.

EXAMPLES

Start it with just the file name:

```
compactcmd c:\logs\sample.mdb
```

Start it with retrying disabled:

```
compactcmd c:\logs\sample.mdb -b=off
```

Configure it to start retrying five times. Retry interval is set to a minute. The file name includes spaces.

```
compactcmd "C:\Program Files\MonitorWare\Agent\sample.mdb" -t=5 -s=60
```
